Going to movies is expensive but it will surely not *break the bank*

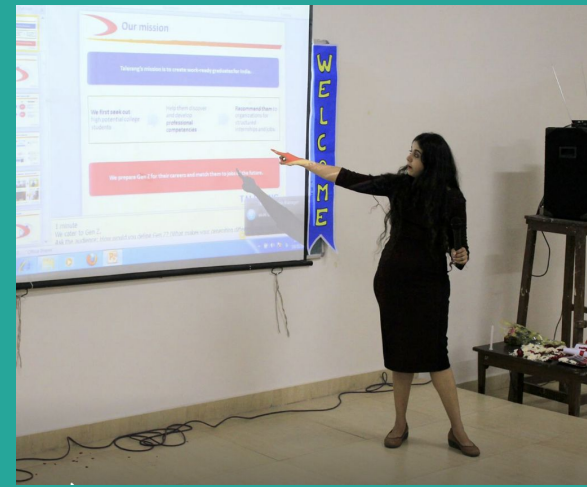
